Re: Homework on Teams

Thank you for all your support with accessing homework on Teams. We know that this is a steep learning curve for all of us and we will continue to refine what we are doing and provide help and guidance to you accessing this at home.

Last week's reading homework was a really good start at uploading photos as evidence of the task completed. We really enjoyed seeing lots of your interesting reading spots so thank you all for your contributions. We would like to remind you of how to submit photo evidence for the homework tasks. Please do not post them on the general posts section as this means they are visible for the whole class. Instead you need to open up the actual assignment in the assignments tab and then upload the photo by using the paperclip symbol to attach the photo and then click turn in.


Please talk with your child's class teacher if you are experiencing any difficulties.



You will be able to see the homework that has been set using the assignments icon down the side – it will also appear in the posts section.


To open the homework, click on assignments



Here you will be able to click on the assignment and see what you need to complete




Once you click on this you will see the full instructions.

Once your child has completed the task, click the paperclip with add work next to it. Upload the photograph or file. Then click Turn in.
