After reviewing our systems for how to notify the school in the event of a positive case we have set up an emergency contact number. During the hours of 8am-4pm Monday to Friday please continue to phone the school to report test results and if you are requiring to self-isolate.

In the event that you receive confirmation of a positive result for your child outside of these hours or at the weekend we request that you inform us immediately by **texting 07527324844**. A member of staff will then contact you back to discuss details and begin taking the relevant action for the rest of the school. This number is only to be used to report a positive result for your child and via text only please. You can contact school during school hours in the usual ways for all other communication. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

Admissions – Primary and Junior School Applications

If your child lives in Northamptonshire, from 10 September 2020, you can make an application for a:

- primary school place for September 2021 if your child has their 4th birthday between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021
- junior school place for September 2021 if your child has their 7th birthday between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 and is in year 2 at an infant school
