

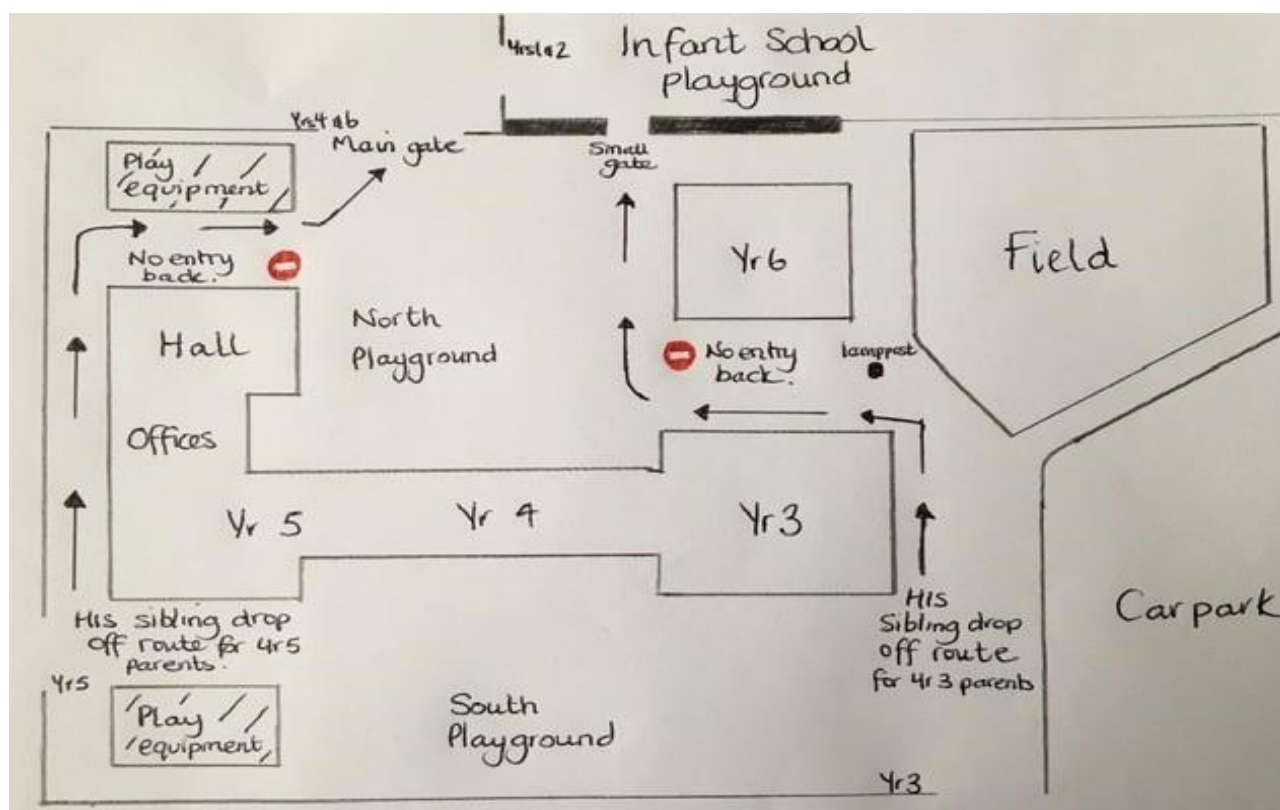
Introduction of a one-way system

During the Autumn term it was raised by a few parents that due to all movement occurring outside the school premises, the pavement that runs adjacent to the school was becoming increasingly congested. We have reviewed our operating procedures in line with our latest risk assessment and have made some adaptations to help resolve this issue. From 8th March there will be a one-way system from the South Playground (HJS) through to the North Playground (HJS) to reduce traffic on the surrounding pavements.

How will it work?

All parents and children will enter school through their assigned gates (please see your child's year group letter emailed 2/3/21) as they did during the Autumn term. However, if your child is in Yr 3 or Yr 5 and you have a sibling to take or collect in Year 6, Year 4 or the Infant school there will be a one-way flow of traffic from the South Playground to the North playground and Infant school. This is outlined as follows:

- Drop off/collect in Year 3 then come around in between the main school and Year 6 buildings and up through the North playground.
- Drop off/collect in Year 5 use the path that runs around the side of the school between the offices and the main fence.

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- Children in **Anning** class enter through the North playground and use the grassed area adjacent to the scooter track to walk round to their classroom. They also exit this way too.

In order to minimise contact and reduce congestion on our playgrounds we ask that if you do not have any siblings to take to the infant school you exit via the same gate you entered and not use the one-way system.

Please note this is a one-way system that will be in operation both before and after school.
There is no access from the Infant School or North Playground to the South Playground. We also ask that it not to be used as a through route for those without children in Years 3 and 5. Please use paths on both sides of the road around the school site for access for other year groups.

In order to keep everyone safe we kindly ask you please follow the guidance outlined in the letters that have been sent recently so to reduce the risk of spreading COVID to others and causing further bubble closers.
